- O Evidence-based





## Data: The Progress

- O Since 2021 34% increase in shelter beds
- 2021-22 cold weather season zero deaths due to cold weather exposure
- O In 2022 72% reduction in veteran homelessness
- In 2022 1,380 exits from homelessness to housing

- O Eviction Prevention Subcommittee
- Eviction Prevention Resource Guide distributed by Justice Center
- Emergency Rental Assistance
- Legal Aid Assistance \$50k
- Tenant-Landlord Mediation \$170k
- Mobile Home Initiative \$100k



#### **Homeless Services**


- Full geographic street outreach coverage
- O Built for Zero
- SMART Bench \$6k
- Respite Housing \$150k
- O Long Distance Travel Fund \$20k
- Up & Adams \$500k (coming soon)
- Lyft Rides \$50k (1,406 rides in 2022)
- Mobile services expansion
  - Laundry and shower \$24k
  - Mobile mental health \$600k\*



# Highlight: Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP)


- O Paperless
- 1,155 unique clients this winter season
- 13,000+ nights of homelessness averted since November
- December 2022 exceeded 410 vouchers in one night
- SWAP Budget
  - O 2020 \$100k
  - O 2021 \$250k
  - O 2022 \$700k
  - 2023 \$1.36M\*

\*Additional ARPA funding to meet the needs




# Highlight: Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP) - 2022-23

- 60% listed Adams County as last permanent residence
  - Jeffco 10% (N size grew by 98% year over year)
  - Out-of-state 7% (N size by grew 210% year over year)
  - Weld 2% (N size grew by 58% year over year)
- 22% slept in Thornton the night before activation (unique clients)
  - 16% in Westminster
  - 15% in Northglenn
