**A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT CONCERNING CRISIS AND
WITHDRAWAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS the City of Westminster (“City”) is empowered pursuant to Article XIV, Section 18, of the Colorado Constitution and Sections 29-1-201, *et seq.*, C.R.S., to cooperate or contract via intergovernmental agreement with other governmental entities to provide functions, services, or facilities authorized to each cooperating government; and

WHEREAS the City and other participating local governments in Jefferson County (collectively, the “Jurisdictions”) have depended upon the Jefferson Center for Mental Health (“Jefferson Center”) to provide 24/7 crisis walk-in and mobile services, as well as intoxication and withdrawal management (collectively, the “Services”); and

WHEREAS the Jurisdictions have determined it is in the best interest of their residents to continue receiving the Services from Jefferson Center for the foreseeable future pursuant to the terms of the Agreement Concerning Crisis and Withdrawal Management Services (“Agreement”), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1; and

WHEREAS the Jurisdictions desire to enter into the Agreement to provide funding to Jefferson Center for continuation of the Services; and

WHEREAS the execution of the Agreement will serve a public purpose and will promote the health, safety, and general welfare of inhabitants in and around the City and Jefferson County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER:

1. The Agreement Concerning Crisis and Withdrawal Management Services attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is hereby approved.

2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City.
