- (1) Fire Department vacancy rate (-2.72%) reflects four (4) additional line staff hired for the Spring 2023 Fire Academy, in response to future known and anticipated vacancies. With the challenge facing fire departments nationwide of shrinking talent pools, as well as the hiring restriction caused by limited annual academies for training new recruits, the strategy of over-hiring quality Firefighter recruits for each academy ensures that service levels to the community are continually met, even with regular staff attrition.
- (2) In the first quarter of 2023, there were three (3) Police Sworn personnel separations and four (4) Police Sworn personnel hired. As of March 31, 2023, there are 16 Police Sworn candidates active in the final stages of the recruitment process.
