#### **Summary Statement:**

- Economic Development Week was created by the International Economic Development Council (IEDC) in 2016 to increase awareness of local economic development programs that create jobs, generate community wealth, and improve the quality of life in communities everywhere.
- The City's Economic Development Department works with a wide variety of business support programs, creates public private partnerships, builds relationships with the business community, unlocks workforce development opportunities for residents, promotes the city as a business and workforce destination of choice, encourages private sector investment in the community, sparks redevelopment and adaptive reuse, supports balanced housing, promotes sustainable business practices, and engages in placemaking activities, among many other efforts, to support the economic prosperity of Westminster.
